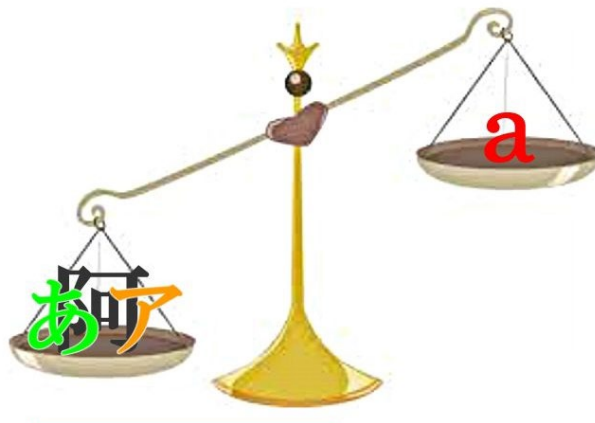

Today`s topics

(What should I do?)

Almost no Japanese speak English anyway.

What should I do?

In English basic letters only 26 alphabets.

But in Japanese basic letters at least 2100, Hiragana(ひらがな)50 letters, Katakana(カタカナ)50 letters and Kanji (漢字 = かんじ) 2000 letters, from the first total 2100 letters minimum.

OMG!! It`s a hell road!! Impossible!!

We never can stand on start line anytime.

What should I do?

We guess maybe You feel so.

But plz calm down and settle here down.

We Japanese have 4<sup>th</sup> letter way.

It means, 1<sup>st</sup> is Hiragana, 2<sup>nd</sup> is Katakana, 3<sup>rd</sup> is Kanji and then 4<sup>th</sup> is “Rooma-ji” way.

Rooma-ji is the same as alphabet letter, 26 letters only.

For example,

わたしはがいきくじんです。(1<sup>st</sup> way)

ワタシハガイコクジンデス。(2<sup>nd</sup> way)

私は外国人です。(3<sup>rd</sup> way)

And

Watashi wa Gaikoku-ji desu.(4<sup>th</sup> way)

Our lesson at the first uses 4<sup>th</sup> way (Rooma-ji) and English only for easily understanding and speaking in Japanese.
