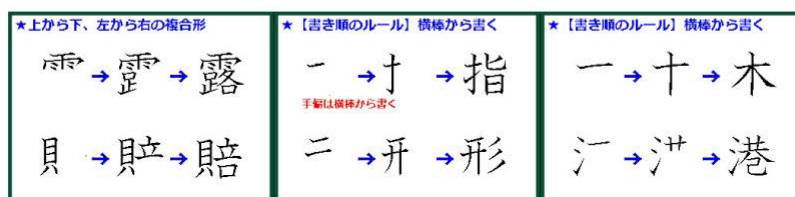

(kanji writing order(stroke order)漢字の書き順)

From my observations, foreigner`s writing order (stroke order) for Kanji, it looks like a sketch drawing the object in front of them. No, it seems that “No order”

But we Japanese know Kanji has several rules for writing order (stroke order)

The rule is

Write (you foreigners maybe say,” No, it`s writing but drawing!!”)

First order, from left side to right side.

And next order, write from upside to downside.

Or sometime oppositely, vasa versa

First, from upside to downside, next, left side to right side.

Above case by case, each Kanji different.

Anyway, it has rules, then we Japanese say it not “drawing” Kanji but “writing” Kanji.
