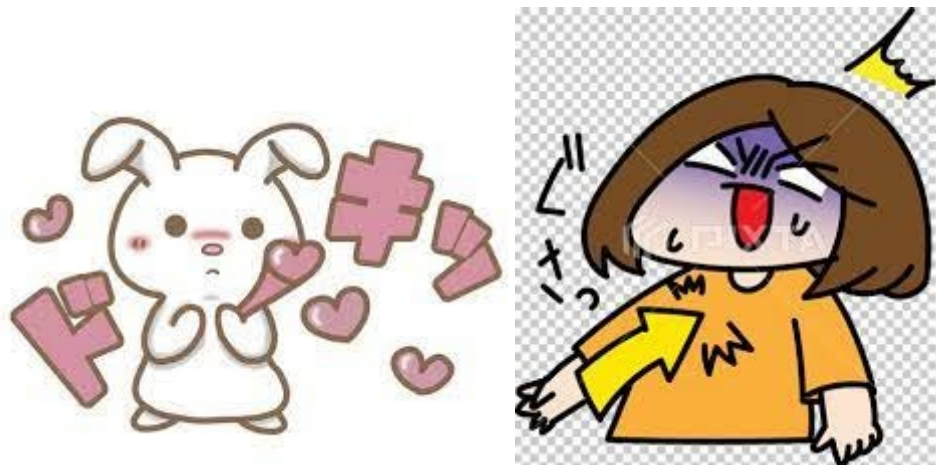

Today`s onomatopoeia is below.

When Japanese got shocked, we say “Doki !!” or “Gusa !!”

Doki!!(ドキッ!!) is the sound of heart strong pumping.

Doki!!(ドキッ!!) means “Your saying hits my hidden point” or “You already noticed my secret truth” or “you wear off veil from my covered secret” then shocked.

Gusa!!(ぐさっ!!) is the sound of being attacked to one`s body by knife or arrow.

Gusa!!(ぐさっ!!) means” Your saying hurts my heart” or “phycological pressure attacked me” then shocked.

Sometimes after Doki or Gusa, we will attach next phrase,

“Surudoigo-shiteki!!” (スルドイごしてき) (鋭い指摘)
